- Patrolman annual salary is approximately \$58,000 to \$66,000 annually

Minimum Qualifications

Candidates MUST:

- ✓ Have a High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- ✓ Have the ability to obtain a valid Massachusetts firearms license
- ✓ Be at least 21 years old before the examination
- ✓ Pass an entrance examination
- ✓ Pass oral interviews
- ✓ Pass a thorough background investigation prior to employment.
- ✓ Pass a physical fitness test
- ✓ Pass a medical examination
- ✓ Pass a psychological examination
- ✓ Be a United States citizen
- ✓ Have a valid driver's license
- ✓ Write and speak English fluently
- ✓ Reside within 15 miles of Seekonk, Massachusetts within one year of appointment.
